<p>At all times safety to any person and all others in the club shall be taken into account even if this results in closing down the club or session</p>
<p>All Club officials and volunteers shall obey the following code</p>
<p>Any of the following rules if broken may result in a disciplinary procedure as stated in the constitution of the Club:-</p>
<p>The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. All volunteers must:</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • consider the well being and safety of participants before the development of performance. • develop an appropriate working relationship with performers, based on mutual trust and respect. • make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part. • promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play). • display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance. • follow all guidelines laid down by the national governing body and the club. • hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover. • never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit or reward. • never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances. • encourage performers to value their performances and not just results.
<p>An individual shall fill in a membership form. If under 18 years old the form shall signed by a parent or guardian who shall abide by the rules and constitution of both Renkeido Judo Kwai and the BJA <u>(See also, Junior / Senior Behaviour Policy)</u></p>
